RESULTS OF FIRST-EVER "STATE OF DIVERSE SMALL BUSINESSES IN CALIFORNIA" REPORT TO BE UNVEILED AT CALIFORNIA DIVERSITY AWARDS JUNE 29TH

SACRAMENTO, CALIF. (June 27, 2023) — On Thursday, June 29, the California African American, California Hispanic, and California Asian Pacific Chambers of Commerce will join forces to honor three outstanding champions of diversity in California. It will release the first-ever State of Diverse Small Business: Economic, Fiscal, and Social Impact Analysis report, recently completed by Beacon Economics and made public for the first time.

The three Chambers partnered to create the California Diversity Awards to honor leaders in diversity, equity, and inclusion (DE&I) in California. An independent panel reviewed nominations and made the following determinations: the awardee for the corporation category for 2023 is Banc of California; the awardee for the public official category is Lieutenant Governor Eleni Kounalakis; and the awardee for the community-based organization is the California Farmworker Foundation.

In addition to this year's awards ceremony, lead researcher Mazen Bou Zeineddine with Beacon Economics will reveal how minority-led small businesses are faring in California following COVID-19, the challenges they face when compared to non-minority firms, and their economic, fiscal, and social impact upon the State broken out by every region in California.
